There are seven prerequisite courses required for admission to the Upper Level Social Work Major. These courses must be completed by the fall semester you intend to begin the program. This is most typically the fall of your junior year. The prerequisites do not need to be completed at the time of application. However, we do need to see that you have a clear plan to finish them by the start of fall semester.

It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that all of the prerequisites are completed by the start of the fall semester. Overall your GPA needs to remain above a 2.0 to remain eligible for admission. A 1.0 is passing for all prerequisite courses except SW200, which requires a 2.0. We recommend that you have a minimum of 42 completed credits at the time of application. Failure to successful complete all prerequisites by the end of summer session B will result in the denial of your admission application.
