Aging Certificate:

Diversity Certificate:

- 1) Take one extra diversity course as approved by the School.
- 2) Attend four diversity related events, trainings, conferences, continuing education programs.

Child Welfare Certificate:

- 1) Complete senior year field placement in a child welfare setting approved by the School.
- 2) Take SW 471 (Child Welfare) and one from SW474, CEP261, PSY244, HDSF225 or approved substitution.
- 3) Attend two child welfare conferences.
