Institute for Health Policy, in partnership with the MSU College of Nursing and the MSU School of Social Work is pleased to announce a seminar for health plan case managers: **Case Management for Children with Special Healthcare Needs and Pediatric Behavior Health and Developmental Delays.**

This *free, one-day seminar* will provide a review of Children with Special Healthcare Needs and Epilepsy, evidence base guidelines, updates on treatment, primary care physician perspective and family perspectives.

**Desired Outcomes:** Case management professionals will be able to: 1. Identify healthcare and behavioral issues in children with epilepsy; 2. Recognize evidence-based treatment options; 3. Locate community and family resources to assist with this population.
